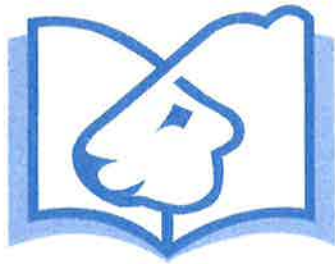

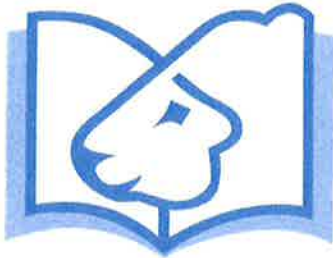
Fri. 27 Pray for Harold as he begins work on printing over 100,000 books for the Congo. Pray for stamina, alertness, and well-functioning equipment.
